Wild Guess Card Game instructions

Print cards on card stock. Set the printer to print on both sides of the paper or feed the paper in twice, flipping it over for the second printing.

Cut the cards apart.

Stack cards in the middle of the table with National Day Calendar® facing up. Decide which player will go first by having each player make a wild guess about something. (For example, guess how many slices of bread remain in the open loaf of bread.) Whoever's wild guess is the most accurate, goes first.

During their turn, each player will take a card. They will try to describe the National Day without using any of the words in the day. They can use hand motions, draw it, sing it, and use other words. The other players take wild guesses to try and guess the day. The player that guesses correctly first, gets to keep the card.

If no one guesses, the card goes to the bottom of the pile and DOES NOT get revealed. It can be played again by another player.

The player with the most cards when all the days have been guessed, wins the game.
